I continue to be impressed by the good work of the Murphy Centre. In June, 70 MC participants graduated from High School. This represents stories of great effort and resilience. This number represents a pass rate of 76% of participants who were eligible to graduate. A total of 200-300 participants were served on the academic side of the operation since September 2021.

In our Career Services program we have seen 538 persons in the fiscal year ended March 31, 2022. This surpasses our recent average subscription rate.

For the past number of years we have witnessed the growing cost of offering various programs required by our participants as well as the need to quickly pivot to address emerging situations. This is guite challenging when the vast majority of funds received are for dedicated purposes. In essence, there is very little flexibility to address new challenges. We are awaiting licensing approval for our very first OnLine 50:50 Draw for the Fall of 2022. We plan for tickets to go on sale on September 26th with the Final Draw held on November 09, 2022.
